There is a strong commitment and recognition that the site needs to fit within the existing architectural style and outdoor loving culture of Bozeman and we have worked to ensure the inclusion of walking paths, biking trails and transportation links which will keep the project connected to the community."

The Innovation Campus will play an important role in economic growth for Bozeman, the Gallatin Valley and the state in coming years.
